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#### To celebrate its much anticipated reopening, Universcience has planned a rich and vibrant cultural season.

Starting with Les Étincelles du Palais de la **découverte**, our temporary eco-friendly home located in the 15<sup>th</sup> arrondissement of Paris. The Palais has relocated to this colourful construction while renovation works are taking place, and we continue to carry out our mission here by offering presentations, workshops and shows at the planetarium.

As for the **Cité des sciences et de l'industrie** visitors will discover Jeans and Renaissances exhibits in person. The firm intention of these exhibits is to question the sustainability of our choices. *E-lab* season 2 explores the latest trends in video games, in terms of the different careers and technologies within the industry, while the Biolab a new demonstration area sees the day.

In June 2022, the Industrial Evolutions exhibition will open its doors. This exhibition explores industrialisation and its impact on human life, through immersive installations.

After the long months of lockdown, this cultural season focuses on the idea of sharing. This autumn, the Cité des sciences et de l'industrie puts the spotlight on a moment of celebration with *Banquet*, an exhibition that will bring visitors from the kitchen to the table. There will also be several events throughout the year: Les Silencieuses (Silent Events), Les Éclatantes (The Blinding Nights), Mini Maker Faire. and the Festicités festival will offer visitors experiences where they can enjoy being and doing something together.

In keeping with its mission, Universcience is aimed at everyone, from babies and toddlers onwards! After three years setting up its Lab, la Cité des bébés (Cité for Babies) will open its doors to babies and toddlers in June 2022, while *Fragile!* (*Fragile !*) a new exhibition for children aged 2-6 will open in February 2022.

This cultural season will be all about **togetherness** and wonder. It's an opportunity for Universcience to show that in today's world, all roads lead to science.

Individual visitors are welcome to visit on Wednesday afternoons, weekends and during zone C school holidays. They can enjoy the same exhibitions as school pupils, and will also be invited to try new interactive tools. They will regularly encounter scientists in the *A Researcher, an Experiment*.

But at a time when wearing jeans, which are by now ubiquitous, goes far beyond a fashion fad, the matter of how to produce them has become a crucial question: how can they be manufactured in large quantities, with a high level of quality and at an affordable price, all while protecting the environment?

### BIO-INSPIRED ANOTHER APPROACH

We can learn an enormous amount from the living world. The organisms that make up this world have learned how to protect themselves, adapt to their environment and resist change. With the environmental challenges we face in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, the living world is an essential source of inspiration. The new permanent exhibition, *Bio-inspired*, *another approach*, which is presented in the greenhouse of the Cité des sciences et de l'industrie, is testament to this. Visitors will be immersed in three different ecosystems (a coral reef, a mangrove and a forest floor), where they will discover biomimicry, a scientific approach which takes inspiration from the living world to imagine a more harmonious and sustainable world.

# CONFERENCES

Every year, almost 100 scientists come to meet the public at the Cité des sciences et de l'industrie.

To reinvent our future, we need to unearth new territories for the human imagination. That's what the "Stories" theme aims to do, which runs from September 2021 to January 2022. It is an opportunity to reflect on the way in which science follows the history of the Universe and of Humanity, and to discover how science itself creates great myths. In the manner of an alternate historian, visitors are invited to imagine how the world would have evolved, had a certain historical event or scientific discovery not taken place. Finally, several future scenarios will be predicted, in order to propel us into action and improve our resilience.

From February to June 2022, we take a look at the question of "Foods", exploring the link between food, pleasure and health, as well as the continual challenge of feeding a growing global population, while protecting against climate change and preserving natural resources. We will also discuss the intellectual nourishment provided by education and culture.

In this multimedia museum space, which is updated twice a year with new themes, visitors to the Cité des sciences et de l'industrie can stay informed about the essential news in the world of science. With four topics per display, this exhibition space helps visitors to understand the issues related to the evolution of science and technology.

The "Vues d'Afrique" film festival opens on 29 June 2021, and forms part of Universcience's participation in the Africa Season 2020. Coordinated by the Lille School of Journalism, around thirty journalists have together drawn up the four "Topical issues". As for the films, all produced by "Haut-Parleurs", they are all the work of young professionals from the region, and provide a framework for new stories, from Maghreb in Sub-Saharan Africa to West Africa.

• From October 2021, Science Actualités will present "Topical issues" dedicated to hydrogen, the emergence of a new submarine volcano in Mayotte, the latest three-dimensional map of the universe, as well as looking at race as a scientific subject.

• In 2022, to mark France's Presidency of the Council of the European Union, there will be a special edition of Science Actualités dedicated to European topics.
